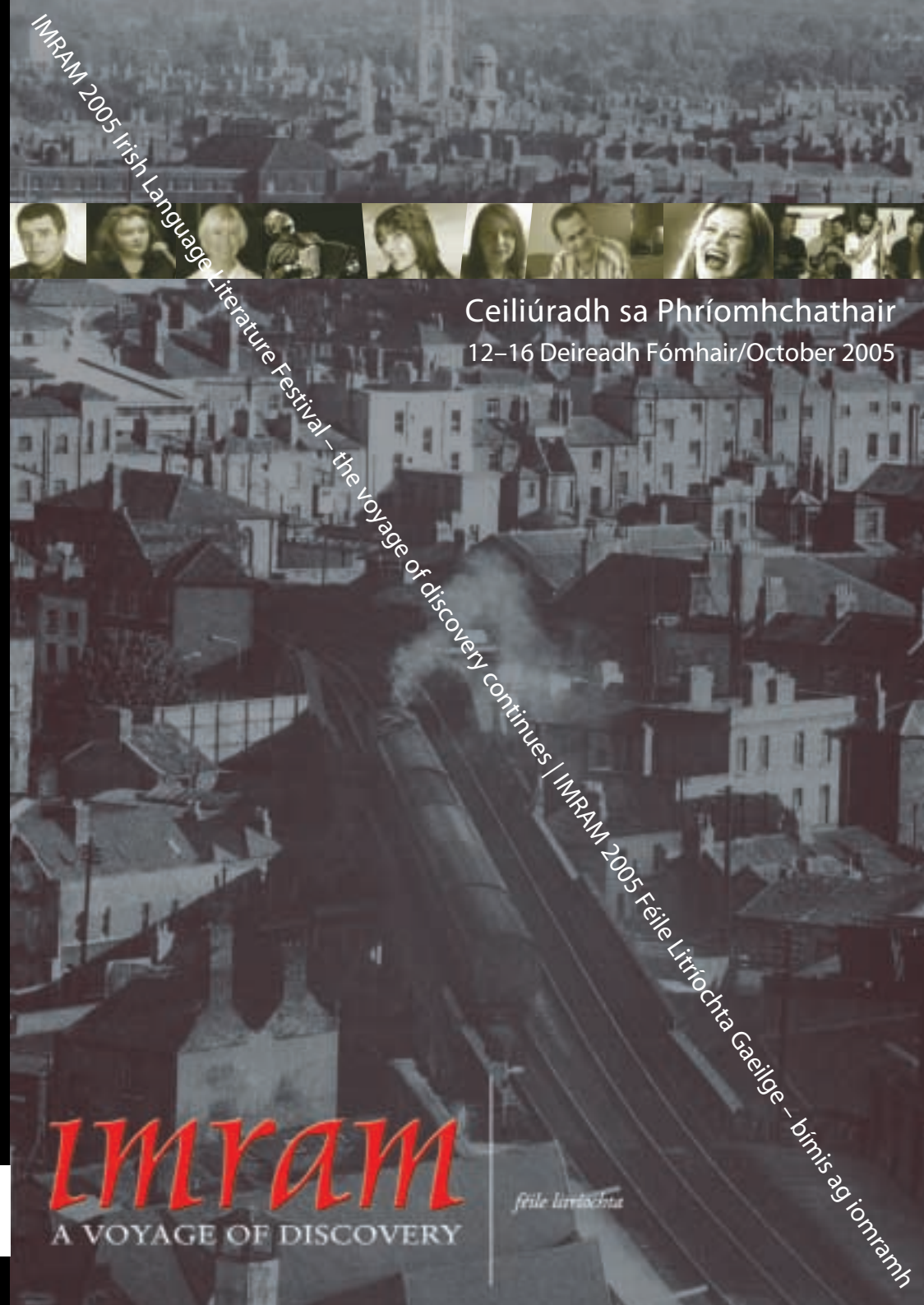

Cathal's volume of poetry *Tonnchríth Intinne* (Coiscéim, 1992) was nominated for the *Irish Times Literary Award*.

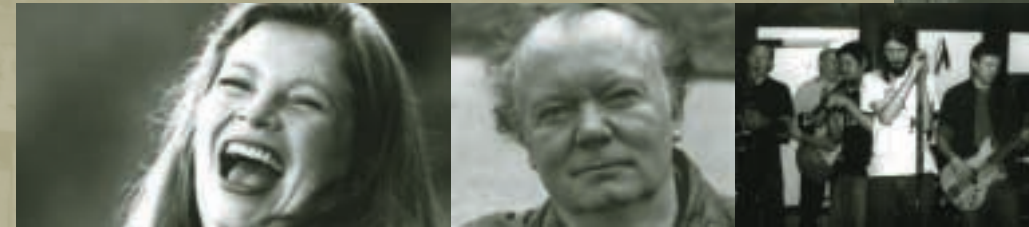
