



The Book Doctors from Children's Books Ireland team make recommendations to young readers after a quick diagnostic chat. Each appointment lasts 15 minutes, and the Doctor can see up to 16 patients a day, so places are limited, and on a first-come, first-served basis. If a family has more than one young reader who'd like to meet the Doctor, please make an individual appointment for each child.


Everyone can draw and everyone can make up a story, so says Aidan Courtney and in this workshop he will show you how to create your own little comic, step by step!
